

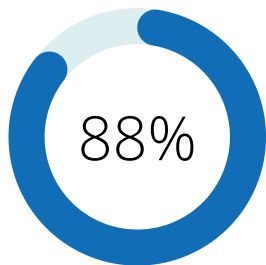
About The Family Promise Program

FPSJC offers shelter and support for local families experiencing homelessness. As a small, family-focused program, we help adults meet their housing goals while keeping kids' safety and well-being a top priority. At our Day Center, we offer multiple family living rooms, a shared play room, a nursery room, and after school activities.

You can also expect:

- 1 on 1 daily assistance to achieve individual and specific goals
- Access to computers and community resources
- Reliable transportation to and from our Host Sites to our Day Center, 7 days a week

Program Eligibility Requirements

- Must currently be experiencing homelessness
- Have at least one child under the age of 18 in your custody
- Drug and alcohol free program
- Pass a background check free from violent crimes and crimes against children

A Typical Day At Family Promise SJC

- ✓ **6:00 AM:** Wake-up time
- ✓ **6:30 AM:** Departure from Host Site
- ✓ **6:45 – 7:00 AM:** Arrival at Day Center. Families get ready for school, work, or upcoming day.
- ✓ **8:00 - 4 PM:** Adults spend day working to make progress toward the goal of self-sufficiency. This may include speaking with our staff, composing a resume, or applying for employment opportunities. Time may also be spent outside the Day Center contacting other agencies, interviewing for jobs, attending meetings, etc.
- ✓ **4:00 PM:** Arrive back at Day Center
- ✓ **5:30 PM:** Departure from Day Center for Host Site
- ✓ **5:45 PM:** Arrival at Host Site
- ✓ **6:00 PM:** Dinner at Host Site
- ✓ **10:00 PM:** Lights out

About Our Host Site



Although Family Promise SJC is not a religious organization, our temporary shelters are hosted in the buildings of partnered religious congregations located within our county. Our unique shelter program hosts up to four families at a time.

Our host sites most important tasks include:

- Providing safe shelter
- Providing 3 meals per day
- Coordinating children's crafts, activities, games, and tutoring
- Offering support and a listening ear
- Loving and warm volunteers



More About Our Day Center Services

At our Day Center we offer:

- Shower and laundry facilities
- Living rooms to spend time with family
- Playroom for children
- Baby room for parents to nurture their babies and toddlers
- Computers to work on resume, apply for housing, etc.
- Lockers to store all valuable belongings

You can also expect:

- One-on-one daily assistance to help you achieve your financial, employment, childcare, and housing goals
- Post program assistance to ensure you don't become homeless again
- Reliable transportation to and from our Host Sites to our Day Center, 7 days a week
