Understanding Our Network



Host Congregations vs. Support Congregations

Our shelter program features temporary accommodations, known as host sites, located within the buildings of the faith community, such as churches and synagogues. Each host site operates for one week at a time and is partnered with a support congregation that assists in providing dedicated volunteers.

What is needed to be a host congregation?

- 4 private or semi-private rooms to host families
- Communal space for dinner & fellowship
- Access to a bathroom (showers not necessary)
- Volunteers
- Provide dinner for each night of host week, along with food supplies for grab-and-go breakfasts and sack lunches

What is needed to be a support congregation?

- Assist partnered congregation by providing volunteers and meals during assigned weeks

A Typical Day At Family Promise SJC



5:45 AM - 7 AM

Families wake up and depart from the host site in the FPSJC van. A to-go breakfast is provided.

7 AM - 6 PM

Children attend school or daycare while adults dedicate their days to pursuing self-sufficiency at our Resource Center. Here, they can engage with our staff, create resumes, and apply for job opportunities, all aimed at helping them achieve their goals.



6 PM - The Next Morning

Families are transported from the Resource Center to the host site, where they enjoy dinner and fellowship with our volunteers. By 10 PM, families settle into their private rooms at the congregation for a restful night.



Program Eligibility Requirements

- Must be a family experiencing homelessness with at least one child, 18 or younger
- Drug and alcohol-free program
- Pass a background check free from violent crimes
